



TERMS OF REFERENCE ARMY RUGBY UNION – CHAIRMAN OF CORPS COMMITTEE

General.

1. The Chairman of the Corps Committee is responsible for the Corps Competitions and providing the representative for all Corps on the ARU Council. The Chairman works under the Director of Community Rugby and will appoint a Corps Committee Secretary to assist in the day to day management of Corps Rugby Competitions.

Role.

2. The primary role of the Chairman of the Corps Committee is to ensure that the Corps Competitions take place and that the views and opinions of the Corps Rugby Committees are represented at the ARU Council. Tasks in detail are:

- Planning and conduct of:
 - The Corps One Day Competition.
 - The Corps Merit Table Competitions, including the Finals Day.
 - The Corps Women's Competition.
- Develop an ethos within the Corps Rugby Community to ensure that all matches within competitions are played and that other individual Corps Rugby initiatives are supported as required.
- Contribute to the planning of the Community Rugby Structured Season.
- Managing the day to day budget for Corps Rugby as provided from Directory Community Rugby and reporting any requirements for overspend or requirements for unplanned expenditure.
- Convene the Corps Committee as necessary during the year to communicate and discuss issues that affect all Corps.
- Develop the links between Corps Rugby and Elite Rugby to ensure that a path for Corps players to be selected at a higher level is available.
- Provide an advisory point to individual Corps Committees on ARU matters.
